



# Own the Night LOW LIGHT Training



**1-Day Session:  
June 3 or November 18**

## Hosted by Lawman Security

Recognizing that most violent encounters occur under diminished or no light environments, Lawman Tactical is introducing a 1 day low light problem solving course geared toward single officer response. The lighting principles and techniques taught will give the officer a better working knowledge of equipment selection, proper employments and weapon light usage.

Instruction will begin in the classroom and move into structures, utilizing handheld and weapon mounted lights appropriately. Students will then be on the range for the second half of the day for work focusing on handheld/ weapon lights and safe manipulation of the weapons system under low light conditions.

### Topics covered will include:

- Safety
- Equipment selection
- Light selection (weapon and handheld)
- Handheld light use for deterrence, control
- Shooting positions
- Transition from handheld to weapon mounted light
- Shooting from cover
- Reloads and malfunctions under low light
- Engagements in low light

### Equipment:

- Rifle (must hand sling)
- 3+ rifle magazines
- Handgun
- Holster and magazine pouches
- Handheld light
- Weapon mounted lights (if used)
- 300 rounds handgun
- 200 Rounds rifle
- Spare batteries for all lights
- Ear and eye protection

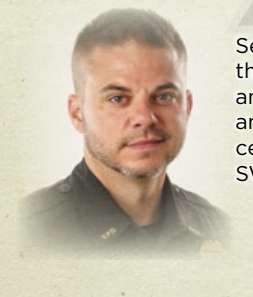
### Optional (recommended) gear:

- Additional magazines for all weapons

## INSTRUCTORS

Sergeant Jacob Taylor has worked for the Evansville Police Department since 2002. He is an active member of the SWAT team since 2007 and currently serves as a team leader. Sergeant Taylor is a LETB Certified Instructor and instructs in these areas Firearms, VCQB, Shoot House, NTOA Active Shooter, Safariland-Def Tech Less Lethal and Low Light instructor. He has attended advanced hostage rescue, vehicle operations school training and is a certified Glock/AR15/H&K Armorer. Currently scheduled to instruct a 2-man tactical course at the Indiana SWAT Officers Association Conference in April 2019.

Officer Kenny Dutschke has been a law enforcement since 2003. He currently works in the EPD Crime Prevention Unit and has served as a member of the SWAT team since 2011. Officer Dutschke is a certified LETB instructor. He has trained in numerous tactical combat courses including TC3, Fulcrum Tactical Advanced Hostage Rescue x2, Redback One Offensive Stronghold Clearance, and Redback One Counter Ambush. Additionally, he completed training at both the Fulcrum Tactical Active Shooter Instructors School and at the National Tactical Officers Association.
